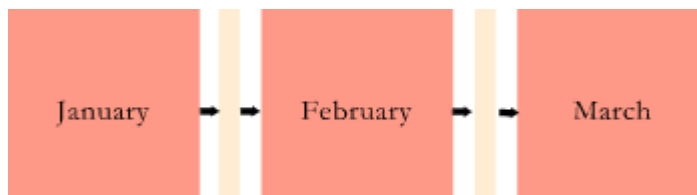
Cutting Instructions:

Fabric:	Size & Shape:	# to Cut:	*2nd Cut:
A (Red)	2-1/2" Square	6	
D (Green)	2-1/2" x Width of Fabric Strip (for binding)	9	
E (Cream)	2-1/2" x 18-1/2" Strip (for sashing)	17	
E (Cream)	2-1/2" x 40-1/2" Strip (for first border)	4	
E (Cream)	2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Strip (for first border)	2	
E (Cream)	2-1/2" x 38-1/2" Strip (for first border)	2	
F (Floral)	6-1/2" x 40-1/2" Strip (for second border)	4	
F (Floral)	6-1/2" x 34-1/2" Strip (for second border)	2	
F (Floral)	6-1/2" x 42-1/2" Strip (for second border)	2	

Sashing Strips Sewing Instructions:

Step 1: Arrange the January block, the February block, the March block, and two 2-1/2" x 18-1/2" Color E (cream) sashing strips as follows:

January block, sashing strip, February block, sashing strip, March block.



Sew together to form the first row. Press the seam allowances toward the sashing strips.

Repeat for rows 2-4.

Step 2: Create the sashing rows by sewing together the following:

Sashing strip, 2-1/2" Color A square, sashing strip, 2-1/2" Color A square, sashing strip.



Press the seam allowances away from the 2-1/2" Color A squares.

Make 3.

Step 3: Using the quilt image ([located here](#)) as your guide, stitch the block rows and sashing rows together to complete the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the sashing rows.

Inner Border Sewing Instructions:

Step 4: Sew a 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" Color E (cream) strip to a 2-1/2" x 22-1/2" Color E (cream) strip along one short side. Press the seam allowance in one direction. Make 2. (Each strip should measure 2-1/2" x 62-1/2".)

Step 5: Sew a 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" Color E (cream) strip to a 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" Color E (cream) strip along one short side. Press the seam allowance in one direction. Make 2. (Each strip should measure 2-1/2" x 78-1/2".)

Step 6: Sew the Step 5 strips to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the Step 5 strips.

Step 7: Sew the Step 4 strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seam allowances toward the Step 4 strips.

Outer Border Sewing Instructions:

Step 8: Sew a 6-1/2" x 40-1/2" Color F (floral) strip to a 6-1/2" x 34-1/2" Color F (floral) strip along one short side. Press the seam allowance in one direction. Make 2. (Each strip should measure 6-1/2" x 74-1/2".)

Step 9: Sew a 6-1/2" x 40-1/2" Color F (floral) strip to a 6-1/2" x 42-1/2" Color F (floral) strip along one short side. Press the seam allowance in one direction. Make 2. (Each strip should measure 6-1/2" x 82-1/2".)

Step 10: Sew the Step 9 strips to the left and right sides of the quilt. Press the seam allowances toward the inner border.

Step 11: Sew the Step 8 strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press the seam allowances toward the inner border. Your quilt top is finished! Quilt and bind as desired.

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
